As the mom of an active (and messy) toddler, I know how much wear and tear kids clothing can get! That's why I love to spruce up my daughter's clothing with simple and colorful patches! Everything from stains to holes can be covered with a patch.

MATERIALS:

Brother™ ScanNCut machine, fabric, canvas, sewing machine

step 1.



With my Brother™ ScanNCut, I started by cutting out a variety of shapes from colorful fabric.

Tip: For best results in cutting fabric, use the high tack fabric support sheet on the standard mat to secure your fabric.

step 2.

I layered my shapes on top of canvas (for more stability).



step 3. Then, using my sewing machine, I added stitched details to my shapes.

step 4. The result is a variety of fun little fabric patches that are ready to be sewn onto clothing!
